She is excellent in her studying and maniac at reading. She became famous for being the Champion of the Arab Reading Challenge 2018, in its 3rd version. She was one of 10.4 million competitors from 44 Arab and foreign countries and nations. She got a prize of 500.000 AED/ \$150.000.

When journalists asked her – there in U.A.E. – about reading, she replied: “Reading is a hospital of minds, because it fires ignorance, dullness and triviality”. Meryem says that she reads books since she was 5 years-old, as well as she loves reading & summarizing books. She could – through her participation – read 200 books, & entered it with just 60 books.


