

When the sunlight reaches the earth, the atmosphere stops some of the heat from going back out into space. This is called the Green House effect. It is important for maintaining life on earth.

Greenhouse gases are the gases in the atmosphere that actually trap the heat we get from sunlight. Carbon dioxide (CO₂) is one of the most important Greenhouse gases.



Belezma national park was created in 1984, and it is one of the most important national parks in Algeria. It is considered as one of the most promising destinations for eco-tourist and wild lovers in Algeria. It is located in Batna province in the Belezma mountains northwest of Batna city in the north eastern region of Algeria. It covers an area of 262.5 square kilometers. The park was designated as a UNESCO biosphere reserve in June 2015.

The diverse ecological regions of the park accommodate over 300 animal species and 440 plant species. Endangered species such as Cuiver's gazelle, Dorcas gazelle and Barbary sheep inhabit the park. Additionally the park has rare plants such as the Atlas cedar which is native to Algeria and Morocco.

Belezma national park is also home to several historical and cultural sites including tombs and caves. Suggested activities in the park are hiking, birding trips and wildlife watching.


