The tower stands about 57 m tall and was built over nearly 200 years, completing in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. The tilt, which initially measured 5.5 degrees, has been reduced to around 3.97 degrees after extensive restoration work in the 1990's and early 2000's. The tower lean has become its defining feature, attracting millions of visitors annually. The tower is made of white marble and has eight stories of arches and columns. The leaning tower of Pisa which is a marvel of medieval engineering was listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site in 1987.
